SPENDING MONEY – The average personal expenditure per camper for snack time, stamps & stationery, toiletries, laundry, pottery, excursions, and other incidentals should be \$50.00 per week. Two camp T-shirts are included in the registration fee. Money for this purpose should be sent along with the camp fee and will be deposited in your daughter's "Country Store" account. The balance will be refunded. Children should not bring money or valuables to camp with them. We accept all major credit cards. There will be a 3.5% customer assistance fee per each credit card transaction. Checks & Cash are preferred.

TELEPHONE - The camp telephone is a business phone. Please do not call unless it is an emergency. Only one line is available. Mail and Email are delivered daily. Camper cell phones are prohibited. DO NOT SEND FOOD. Send books, games or toys. After check in, camp time is changed to Central Time, to allow your daughter more daylight time.

OPTIONAL TRIPS - Scheduled on Sunday, so they do not interfere with riding. Campers who remain in camp have a special program. Chattanooga Trip is \$225. This trip will include Aquarium, IMAX, Coolidge Park, Incline Railway or DeSoto State Park Zip Line. The Ocoee Whitewater Rafting is \$275. Rafters must be 12 and older. A Parental Release Form will be supplied for participants.

LAUNDRY - The camp laundry is sent out once during a two-week session. All articles of clothing, including the laundry bag, should be marked with name tape, stamp, laundry pen, or permanent marker. The camp laundry goes out Fridays, and is returned promptly. Do not send clothing that cannot be washed. like red t-shirts.

HEALTH – The camp nurse is on call for routine medical care during the summer. Expenses for illness or accidents of a nature that call for outside attention will be borne by the parents and their insurance. The medical form will be sent upon enrollment, and must be returned before your daughter's arrival. You must inform us of any medical or emotional issues so we can better plan and prepare for your daughter's experience.

VISITING - It is best, because of adjustment to camp life and programmed activities, not to visit during the two-week session. Our horseshows are for campers, not parents. Visits for campers staying longer must be handled through our office, between sessions.
